AVGP enrolled RISE children for yearlong activity program. Well performing children are engaged for scholarship exam which will help them to tackle hurdles of financial crisis and continued education without having obstacles and could live their dreams. Children are being helped by giving books and educators are being trained to prepare well for the screening. The 1st round of exams

was conducted at our nodal centre on 8th December 2017 in this children were also introduced to use OMR sheets which will be a common practise when these children would appear for any high exams in future. There are numerous ways in which these scholarships have been tailored for the purpose of ensuring that each student may avail to crucial pushing during their educational journeys, depending on their personal aspirations. This is a huge step that has been taken for helping the children to fulfil their dreams and not only that they will get exposer towards the news things and will learn lots of things that will help them to move ahead in a future .the initiative has a longer run in RISE and we are aiming at the PUSH which is required to move towards their dreams.

Training of Teachers



When we talk about Rise Centres the best part of the trainees are that the treat every children as their own. All the educators make sure that the children get family and homely atmosphere where they can study as well as they can be feel comfortable in sharing their feelings. Rise ensures that the educators get all sort of help in doing this so they though to train the trainees in a way that can work in good manner. As we know that the educators are from the local area so its important trainee them in few areas which will helpful for them also, and they can cherish these things in their future life also. So the focus was on communication, English poems, stories, narrations and others factors that we neglect and we don't give attention.

In May training of the trainees held. We at RISE make sure that along with the children, our 10 educators. The aim of these TOTs is to ensure that we give enough food for thought and delivery before every post based learning (PBL) curriculum to the educators. The concepts are cleared, the modus operand of teaching and delivery is taught and communication between the Educator and children should be very clear. She needs to have knowledge of practical down to the grass root. She should not be a mute speaker just to say do this, do that but capable to guide the

children. Every month training of educators is conducted by a master trainer then we ensure educator learn the training schedule with an honest intention that both trainees and organization benefits. Educators are trained to establish a good relation with the students and for Training of Trainers (TOT) the same purpose they are also made to interact with parents & community people too. All educators are trained with immense patience to deal with the students as every person has a different capacity of grasping what is

being taught especially in such extreme circumstances. To make students understand in detail, educators are trained to narrate some stories, facts, incidences to make the matter more realistic. These educators are equipped with special emotional touch as they are dealing with special children of extreme circumstances and struggles. We also discussed the way that all the educators have taught the children of the Rise in the coming months, we all have to encourage the children and encourage them to move forward.

The day started by speech by the educators to children about importance of the family and their role in securing


